









PRE-SEASON INSPECTIONS CHECKLIST

VSI BRINE MAKER

Suggested checkpoints during a pre-season inspection include:

-  Disconnect brine maker from power and clean inside of tank to remove sediment.
-  Ensure salinity probe, batch tank, and agitation nozzle are free of buildup or debris. Inspect for loose hardware or cracked welds, reconnect to power.
-  Update VSI Spray App to the latest version. If unsure, uninstall and reinstall app.
-  Connect brine maker via Bluetooth with the VSI Spray App, then connect the brine maker to Wi-Fi and check for firmware updates. A cyan light indicates Wi-Fi connection, and a magenta light shows an auto-update is in progress.
-  Fill brine tank a quarter full with water and energize pump to pressurize the system. Check for leaks and ensure all nozzles provide proper flow.
-  Fill tank with 60°F water and make a test batch of brine. Compare the digital salinity readout to a manual hydrometer to verify the salinity probe's calibration.
